Beth yw Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Sylfaen?

Arholiad wedi fwriadu'n bennaf ar gyfer oedolion sy'n dysgu Cymraeg ar lefel ôl-ddechreuwyr. Does dim *rhaidd* sefyll arholiad er mwyn dysgu Cymraeg, ond mae'n rhoi rhywbeth i chi anelu ato ac yn eich helpu i wella'ch sgiliau iaith.

Beth yw'r lefel?

Dyma'r ail lefel y gellir sefyll arholiad arni. Mae'r arholiad yma'n addas i ddysgwyr sydd wedi gorffen **Cwrs Sylfaen** neu sydd ar lefel debyg. Mae'r cymhwyster hwn yn cyfateb i lefel A2 yn fframwaith Ewrop (CEFR).

Beth fydd ar gael yn 2023?

Bydd CBAC yn cynnig yr arholiadau'n llawn yn 2023. Hynny yw, bydd modd sefyll y profion Gwrandu, Darllen, Ysgrifennu a Siarad ac ennill cymhwyster llawn.

Ydy hi'n bosib sefyll y prawf Siarad yn unig?

Ydy. Byddwch chi'n cael datganiad cyrhaeddiad, nid cymhwyster llawn. Pan fyddwch chi'n cofrestru gyda'ch canolfan arholi, rhaid i chi nodi mai dim ond y prawf Siarad dych chi eisiau'i wneud. Fyddwch chi ddim yn gallu newid eich cofrestriad yn hwyrach. Os dych chi *wedi* sefyll y prawf Siarad ar y lefel hon yn barod, mae'n bosib gwneud y profion eraill (Darllen, Ysgrifennu a Gwrandu) er mwyn cwblhau'r cymhwyster. Anfonir peth o'r data hyn, sef enwau blaen, cyfenw, dyddiad geni a rhyw, gan y Ganolfan Dysgu Cymraeg Genedlaethol i CBAC. Mae'n angenrheidiol rhannu eich data personol yn y modd hwn er mwyn eich galluogi i sefyll yr arholiad a derbyn dyfarniad. Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Sylfaen 2023

It's possible that the arrangements or availability of the tests may change. Neither WJEC nor exam centres can guarantee that the exam will be available in full in your area.

What is Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Sylfaen?

An exam intended primarily for adults who are learning Welsh at a post-beginners level. You don't *have* to sit an exam to learn Welsh, but it does give you something to aim for, and will help you improve your language skills.

What is the level?

This is the second level at which you can sit an exam. This exam is suitable for learners who have finished Cwrs Sylfaen or who are on a similar level. This qualification corresponds to A2 level in the European framework (CEFR).

What will be available in 2023?

WJEC will provide the full exams in 2023. That is, it will be possible to take the Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking tests and gain a full qualification. However, your exam centre will decide if this will be available in your area.

Is it possible to take the Speaking test only?

Yes. You'll receive a statement of attainment, not a full qualification. When you register with your exam centre, you must let them know that you wish to take the Speaking test only. You will not be able change the registration later. If you *have* taken the Speaking test at this level already, it's possible to take the other tests (Reading, Writing and Listening) in order to complete the qualification. The Speaking test mark may be carried forward for one year only. If you wish to do this, you must let your exam centre know when you register.

When will this take place?

It will be possible to sit the exam on this date:
Friday 23 June 2023

By when do I need to register?

You must register by 1 March 2023. Late registrations will not be accepted.

How much does the exam cost?

There is no fee for candidates who have registered on a 'Learn Welsh' course in 2022-23. However, it's possible that your centre may claim a fee from you, if you don't take the exam after registering. If you are a private candidate, contact your exam centre for information about the fee.

How do I register?

All candidates must register with their 'Learn Welsh' provider. *You* are responsible for this, not your tutor. You can not register directly with WJEC. The contact details are at the end of this document.

An Outline of the Examination

There are several parts to the exam, testing the language skills you are learning in your Welsh class.

1. **Listening** 20%

- i. Telephone Messages
- ii. Item
- iii. Conversations

2. **Speaking** 50%

- i. Getting information
- ii. Talking about yourself
- iii. Asking the interviewer questions

3. **Reading and Gap-filling** 15%

- i. Short article
- ii. Identifying the gist of a message
- iii. Gap filling

4. **Writing** 15%

- i. Writing a note or message
- ii. Responding to an e-mail

More details

1. **Listening Comprehension** 20%
You will hear 3 short pre-recorded pieces, three times.
 - i. **Telephone messages**
You must note the main points of 3 telephone messages.
 - ii. **Item**
You must choose the correct option from factual sentences based on the item, e.g. a radio monologue about an event.
 - iii. **Conversations**
You will hear 4 short different conversations and answer 2 questions about each one.

2. **Speaking** 50%

The test usually lasts around 10-12 minutes.

The test will be recorded and assessed externally. Do not register unless you are willing to be recorded in this way.

The interviewer will use language forms which are familiar to you.

The speaking test may possibly be held online. If so, it will be recorded using the teaching platform used by your provider (e.g. Zoom or MS Teams). **Your exam centre will decide how the Speaking test will be held.**

'Face-to-face' Speaking test

You will be given the candidate's sheet at the start of the test and have 1 minute to look at the advertisement (Part 1).

'On-line' Speaking test

Before starting the online speaking test, you will have to show the interviewer photographic ID to confirm your identity. Then, the interviewer will share the screen for you to have 1 minute to look at the advertisement (Part 1) before starting the test.

There are 3 parts to the Speaking test:

i. **Getting information**

On the sheet/screen, there will be an advertisement or notice, with 5 gaps. You must ask the interviewer questions to get the missing information. You do not need to make a note of the answers.

ii. **Talking about yourself**

You will be given a card by the interviewer. / The interviewer will show a slide on the screen. On the card/screen there will be 5 topics – any 5 from this list:

1. Animals
2. Food
3. Healthy living
4. Neighbours
5. Sports
6. Reading
7. Celebrating
8. Interests
9. Clothes
10. I don't like...
11. School days
12. Learning Welsh
13. Work
14. Last holiday
15. Next holiday
16. Favourite place
17. When I was a child...
18. Shopping
19. If I were 18 again...
20. Technology
21. Travel
22. TV or radio
23. Family or friends
24. Next year
25. Last weekend
26. Next weekend
27. The house
28. The area

You have to say something about your personal experience related to each one of the topics on the chosen card. As a guide, it is suggested that you talk for up to a minute about each one.

The interviewer will ask you questions, based on what you've said about each topic.

iii. **Asking the interviewer questions**

The interviewer will then ask you to choose **one** of the topics on the card/screen. You have to ask the interviewer questions related to that topic, and ask follow-up questions based on the interviewer's answers.

You will be assessed on your ability:

- to ask questions correctly
- to ask appropriate questions
- to talk correctly
- to use a range of patterns and vocabulary
- to pronounce Welsh
- to speak fluently
- to interact with another speaker

3. **Reading and Gap-filling** 15%

i. **Short article**

There will be a short article on the paper. You must choose the appropriate statements from a number of options based on the information in the article.

ii. **Identifying the gist of a message**

You must read 4 email messages and 6 possible headings. You must choose the heading which best conveys the gist of the message.

iii. **Gap-filling**

There are 12 sentences given on the paper with a gap in each to be filled.

4. **Writing** 15%

i. **A note or message**

You must write a note or message on a particular topic. A choice of topics is given.

ii. **Answering an email**

You must read a short e-mail and respond appropriately.

You will be assessed on your ability:

- to write accurately
- to use a range of patterns and vocabulary
- to complete the task and fulfil requirements

When are the tests?

The tests will all be held on one specific date. No candidate will be allowed to sit the exam at times other than those noted.

The papers will be in this order, starting at 9.30am:

Reading Comprehension and Gap-filling		40 minutes
Writing		40 minutes
Listening Comprehension	approx.	50 minutes
Speaking Test	approx.	10-12 minutes

The Speaking Test will be held at a designated time in the afternoon, after a lunch break. Your centre will confirm the location of the exam and time of your speaking test before the exam itself.

Results

You will receive your marks for each test approximately eight weeks after sitting the examination, and will receive a certificate usually at the end of September. If you only take the Speaking test, you will receive a statement of attainment. No grades are awarded for this exam, only Pass or Fail. To pass, you usually need to attain 60% of the possible marks, but the exact grade boundaries are decided at an award meeting.
