

Beth yw Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Mynediad?

Arholiad wedi ei fwriadu'n bennaf ar gyfer oedolion sy'n dysgu Cymraeg ar lefel dechreuwyr. Does dim rhaid sefyll arholiad er mwyn dysgu Cymraeg, ond mae'n rhoi rhywbeth i chi anelu ato ac yn eich helpu i wella'ch sgiliau iaith.

Beth yw'r lefel?

Dyma'r lefel isaf y gellir sefyll arholiad arni. Mae'r arholiad yma'n addas i ddysgwyr sydd wedi gorffen Cwrs Mynediad neu sydd ar lefel debyg. Mae'r cymhwyster hwn yn cyfateb i lefel A1 yn fframwaith Ewrop (CEFR).

Beth fydd ar gael yn 2024?

Bydd CBAC yn cynnig yr arholiadau'n llawn yn 2024. Hynny yw, bydd modd sefyll y profion Gwrando, Darllen, Ysgrifennu a Siarad ac ennill cymhwyster llawn.

Ydy hi'n bosib sefyll y prawf Siarad yn unig?

Ydy. Byddwch chi'n cael datganiad cyrhaeddiad, nid cymhwyster llawn. Pan fyddwch chi'n cofrestru gyda'ch canolfan arholi, rhaid i chi nodi mai dim ond y prawf Siarad dych chi eisiau'i wneud. Fyddwch chi ddim yn gallu newid eich cofrestriad yn hwyrach. Os dych chi *wedi* sefyll y prawf Siarad ar y lefel hon yn barod, mae'n bosib gwneud y profion eraill (Darllen, Ysgrifennu a Gwrando) er mwyn cwblhau'r cymhwyster y flwyddyn ganlynol. **Dim ond am un flwyddyn y gellir cario marc y prawf Siarad.** Os dych chi eisiau gwneud hyn, rhaid i chi roi gwybod i'ch canolfan arholi pan fyddwch chi'n cofrestru.

Erbyn pryd mae'n rhaid cofrestru?

Ar gyfer arholiad Ionawr, rhaid cofrestru erbyn 7 Rhagfyr 2023.

Ar gyfer arholiadau haf 2024, rhaid cofrestru erbyn 1 Mawrth 2024.

Fydd cofrestriadau hwyr ddim yn cael eu derbyn.

Faint mae'r arholiad yn ei gostio?

- ii. **Deialog**
Yma, rhaid i chi ddarllen deialog ac ateb cwestiynau'n seiliedig ar yr wybodaeth yniddi.
- iii. **Llenwi bylchau**
Mae 10 brawddeg ar y papur a bwlch ym mhob un i'w lenwi.

Yn rhannau i. a ii. fyddwch chi ddim yn colli marciau am wallau sillafu na gramadeg yn eich ymatebion.

4. **Ysgrifennu** 10%
- i. **Cerdyn post**
Mae 5 gair/ymadrodd ar y papur a rhaid i chi gynnwys y rhain mewn cerdyn post.
 - ii. **Portread byr ar sail diagram**
Rhoddir diagram ar y papur a nifer o luniau/symbolau'n disgrifio'r person yn y canol. Rhaid i chi ysgrifennu 5 brawddeg am y person yn seiliedig ar y lluniau/symbolau hynny.

Mae'r prawf hwn yn asesu eich gallu i ysgrifennu'n gywir.

Pryd mae'r profion?

Cynhelir y profion i gyd ar ddiwrnod penodol. Ni chaniateir i ymgeiswyr sefyll yr arholiad ar amserau gwahanol i'r rhai a nodir.

Canlyniadau

Byddwch chi'n cael eich marc am bob prawf tua wyth wythnos wedyn, ac yn derbyn dystysgrif fel arfer tua diwedd mis Medi. Os byddwch chi'n sefyll y prawf Siarad yn unig, byddwch chi'n derbyn datganiad cyrhaeddiad. Does dim graddau ar gyfer yr arholiad hwn, dim ond Llwyddo neu Fethu.

Diogelu data

Anfonir peth o'r data hyn, sef enwau blaen, cyfenw, dyddiad geni a rhyw, gan y Ganolfan Dysgu Cymraeg Genedlaethol i CBAC. Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Mynediad 2024

What is Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Mynediad?

An exam intended primarily for adults who are learning Welsh at a beginners level. You don't have to sit an exam to learn Welsh, but it does give you something to aim for, and will help you improve your language skills.

What is the level?

This is the lowest level at which you can sit an exam. This exam is suitable for learners who have finished Cwrs Mynediad, or who are on a similar level. This qualification corresponds to A1 level in the European framework (CEFR).

What will be available in 2024?

WJEC will provide the full exams in 2024. That is, it will be possible to take the Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking tests and gain a full qualification.

Is it possible to take the Speaking test only?

Yes. You'll receive a statement of attainment, not a full qualification. When you register with your exam centre, you must let them know that you wish to take the Speaking test only. You will not be able change the registration later. If you *have* taken the Speaking test at this level already, it's possible to take the other tests (Reading, Writing and Listening) in order to complete the qualification. **The Speaking test mark may be carried forward for one year only.** If you wish to do this, you must let your exam centre know when you register.

When will this take place?

It will be possible to sit the exam on three different dates:

Friday 26 January 2024

Tuesday 11 June 2024

Thursday evening 13 June 2024

You must indicate which date you wish to take the test on registration.

Your exam centre will let you know the exact time of your Speaking test a few days before the day itself.

By when do I need to register?

For the January Mynediad exam, you must register by 7 December 2023. For the summer 2024 exams, you must register by 1 March 2024. **Late registrations will not be accepted.**

How much does the exam cost?

There is no fee for candidates who have registered on a ‘Learn Welsh’ course in 2023-24. However, it’s possible that your centre may claim a fee from you, if you don’t take the exam after registering. If you are a private candidate, contact your exam centre for information about the fee.

How do I register?

All candidates must register with their ‘Learn Welsh’ provider. You are responsible for this, not your tutor. You can not register directly with WJEC. The contact details are at the end of this document.

Neither WJEC nor exam centres can guarantee that the exam will be available in your area.

An Outline of the Examination

There are several parts to the exam, testing the language skills that you're learning in your Welsh class.

1. Listening Comprehension 20%

- i. Dialogue
- ii. Weather bulletin
- iii. Times and prices

2. Speaking 55%

- i. Reading a dialogue aloud
- ii. Answering questions
- iii. Answering questions about a picture
- iv. Asking questions

3. Reading Comprehension and Gap-filling 15%

- i. Advertisements
- ii. Dialogue
- iii. Gap-filling

4. Writing 10%

- i. Writing a post-card
- ii. Writing a short portrait based on a picture

More details

1. Listening Comprehension 20%

You will hear three short, pre-recorded pieces, three times.

i. **Dialogue**

You must choose the appropriate answer in response to simple factual questions about the dialogue.

ii. **Weather bulletin**

You must listen to a simple weather bulletin and complete sentences describing the weather, on the basis of information in the bulletin.

iii. **Times and prices**

There are a number of announcements on the CD, and you must note the start times and prices of the events described.

2. Speaking

The test usually lasts around 7-8 minutes.

The test will be recorded and assessed externally. Do not register unless you are willing to be recorded in this way.

The interviewer will use language forms which are familiar to you.

The speaking test may be held online. If so, it will be recorded using the teaching platform used by your provider (e.g. Zoom or MS Teams). **Your exam centre will decide how the Speaking test will be held.**

‘Face-to-face’ Speaking test

You will be given the candidate’s sheet at the start of the test and have 2 minutes to look at the dialogue (Part 1).

‘On-line’ Speaking test

Before starting the on-line speaking test, you will have to show the interviewer photographic ID to confirm your identity. Then, the interviewer will share the screen for you to have 2 minutes to look at the dialogue (Part 1) before starting the test.

There are 4 parts to the test:

i. **Reading aloud**

You will read a short dialogue aloud with the interviewer. Your pronunciation will be assessed in this part.

ii. **Answering the interviewer's questions**

The interviewer will ask you simple personal questions in Welsh, e.g. What do you like doing in your spare time? You should answer using complete sentences.

iii. **Answering questions about a picture**

On the sheet/screen there will be a picture of a person with a number of facts about him/her. The interviewer will ask questions and you must answer using complete sentences based on the prompts on the sheet/screen.

iv. **Asking the interviewer**

There are 5 written words or phrases on the sheet/screen to be used as a basis for asking 5 questions, e.g. for the word 'byw' you could ask *Ble dych chi'n byw?/Lle dach chi'n byw?*

In parts ii-iv you will be assessed on your ability to answer and ask questions correctly. Full details about how the assessment criteria are applied are available in the specification, which is on the WJEC website: www.wjec.co.uk, (see under 'Welsh for Adults Mynediad').

3. Reading Comprehension and Gap-filling 15%

i. **Advertisements**

There are advertisements on the paper and a number of questions based on them. You have to give short answers, not sentences.

ii. **Dialogue**

Here, you must read a dialogue and answer questions based on the information given.

iii. **Gap-filling**

There are 10 sentences on the paper with a gap in each one to be filled.

In parts i. and ii. you will not lose marks for spelling or grammar errors in your responses.

4. Writing 10%

i. **Post-card**

There are 5 words/phrases on the paper which you must include in a post-card.

ii. **Short portrait based on a diagram**

You are given a diagram on the paper and a number of pictures/symbols describing the person in the centre. You must write 5 sentences about the person based on those pictures/symbols.

This test assesses your ability to write correctly.

When are the tests?

The tests will all be held on specific dates. No candidate will be allowed to sit the exam at times other than those noted.

The papers will be in this order, starting at 10am¹:

Reading Comprehension and Gap-filling	30 minutes
Writing	30 minutes
Listening Comprehension	approx. 25 minutes
Speaking Test	approx. 7-8 minutes

The Speaking Test will be held at a designated time in the afternoon, after a lunch break. Your centre will confirm the location of the exam and time of your speaking test before the exam itself.

Results

You will receive your marks for each test approximately eight weeks after sitting the examination, and will receive a certificate usually at the end of September. If you only take the Speaking test, you will receive a statement of attainment. No grades are awarded for this exam, only Pass or Fail.

¹ If the exam is available on Thursday evening 13 June 2024 in your centre, the tests will commence at 6pm and follow the same order. The Speaking tests will start soon after 7.30 and will be held at different times until around 9pm. Different papers are used for each different session.

Data protection

If you register to take an exam with your ‘Learn Welsh’ provider, you will be asked to provide certain personal data. Your registration data will be shared with the National Centre for Learning Welsh. Some of these data, i.e. forenames, surname, date of birth and gender, will be sent by the National Centre for Learning Welsh to WJEC. It is necessary for your personal data to be shared in this way in order to facilitate your taking the exam and receiving an award. Please be aware that your contact details will *not* be shared with WJEC and any queries you have in relation to the exam should be directed to your exam centre, i.e. your ‘Learn Welsh’ provider.

Special Requirements

If you have any special requirements, which may affect fair access to the exam, e.g. hearing or vision impairment, or physical requirements, you must inform your exam centre by the registration date.
